Rotary Youth Leadership Award

RYLA is leadership training for young adults (ages 19-25). It is lead by a professional facilitator experienced in youth leadership development and supported by Rotarians as well as former RYLA participants.

Junior Rotary Youth Leadership

Jr. RYLA is leadership training for youth (ages 15-18). Our Rotary Club covers the expenses to send a Norfolk County high school student to an in-person weekend program and virtual sessions with other youth from our Rotary district.

Skilled facilitators lead a variety of activities for students that are designed to further develop their leadership skills and self-confidence while meeting and working with others.

RYE is the leading international exchange program in the world. Each year our Rotary Club provides the opportunity for a high school student (ages 15-18) to experience a new culture, learn a new language and develop life-long leadership skills by living in another country.

LONG TERM EXCHANGES:

These exchanges are suited to students who are leaders in their schools and communities. They are about a year long and coincide roughly with our school year. Nearly all 200 countries and geographical regions where Rotary Clubs exist support this program. The Rotary Club of Norfolk Sunrise sponsors both an inbound exchange student and an outbound exchange student. Students are hosted by local families and attend school while on exchange.

SHORT TERM EXCHANGES:

These <u>reciprocal</u> exchanges offer high school students a chance to tailor an exchange to match interests and/or include specific places. Students are supported by our own Rotary club and will live with a host family that is approved by Rotary. Exchanges generally last for a few weeks during the summer months (when school is not in session).

New Generations Service Exchange

NGSE is designed for young adults (ages 18-30) who are in university students or just starting their professional career. It provides opportunities for selected applicants to learn more about their chosen career in another country. The exchanges can last for anywhere from a few weeks to 6 months.

Participants in this exchange are sponsored by local Rotary clubs who facilitate finding them career partners/businesses who they can job shadow and learn from. Local families (usually Rotarians) serve as hosts.
